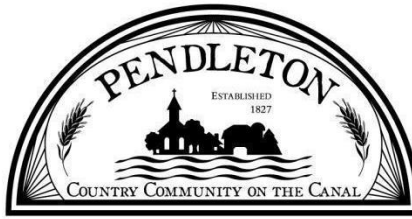

At the meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton, Niagara County, New York, held in the Board Room at the Town of Pendleton Town Hall, 6570 Campbell Boulevard, Lockport, New York, 14094 at 7:00 p.m. on April 13, 2026.

### **Resolution Approving Expenditure for Court Bench Fabrication**

**WHEREAS**, the Justices of the Town of Pendleton did submit a grant application for funding through the 2025-2026 Justice Court Assistance Program (JCAP) and did receive a funding award for specific expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board did approve acceptance of the JCAP funding award by resolution at the March 23, 2026 meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Justices have requested authorization for an expenditure funded by the JCAP in the amount of \$6,280.00 for fabrication and installation of a motorized platform for the bench in the Town Hall Meeting Room, as detailed in the grant award letter; and

**WHEREAS**, the bench currently in place in the Meeting Room was fabricated and installed through funding awarded through the 2023-2024 Justice Court Program (JCAP); and

**WHEREAS**, the work to fabricate and install the Meeting Room bench involved specialized design and fabrication skills and the contractor chosen for this work was selected on the basis of cost and qualification; and

**WHEREAS**, modification to the existing bench will improve accessibility, functionality, and operational effectiveness and requires a high level of skill and experience to match and integrate the new work into the existing installation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board finds that the required modifications constitute a sole source procurement due to the need for compatibility with the existing custom-fabricated bench and the specialized knowledge required for its modification; and

**WHEREAS**, the quote provided has been reviewed for content, qualification, and cost and has been deemed acceptable; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate to approve the work, as requested by the Justices, to be completed by the original contractor who fabricated and installed the existing bench located in the Town Hall Meeting Room.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 2026 that it is hereby determined that the proposed work constitutes a sole source procurement due to the need for compatibility with the existing custom-fabricated bench.

**FUTHER, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board authorizes the expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$6,280.00 to Boards and Blocks by Lucas, for the fabrication and installation of a motorized platform as set forth in the proposal with such expenditure to be funded through the Justice Court Assistance Program (JCAP).
